Lindsley. At his residence, Lemington, near this city, on the evening of the 20th, Eleazer Lindsley, after a protracted illness. His funeral will take place tomorrow Sunday afternoon, at half past 2 o'clock, from his late residence. Carriages will be in waiting at the house of his son-in-law, Hudson Taylor, corner D and Ninth streets at half past one o'clock, to convey those desirous of attending.
