### **Death of Mr. Loewenthal From Cholera**

Last evening, Mr. Jacob Loewenthal of the Union Claim Agency in this city, died at his rooms, No. 367, Pa. avenue, opposite the National Hotel, of cholera. Mr. Loewenthal contracted the disease in New York on Friday last, and on arriving here Saturday had the premonitory symptoms. He was seriously attacked at 4 a.m. yesterday, when Drs. F. Howard and T. Miller were called in. The patient soon was in a collapsed state, and died about 8 o'clock last evening. The physicians say that this is a well marked case of Asiatic cholera.
