Dr. Herbert MacNamee, Retired Dentist, Dies

Dr. Herbert MacNamee, 86, retired District dentist who practiced here 55 years, died Friday after a long illness at his home, 2114 O st. nw.

A native of Armenia, N.Y., Dr. MacNamee graduated from George Washington University Dental School in 1894. In 1949 he retired because of illness.

Dr. MacNamee was a thirty-second degree Mason, Knights Templar no. 1, Scottish Rite and a Shriner. He also belonged to the District Dental Society, the district Dental Dinner Club and District Chapter, Society of the Sons of the American Revolution.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Eva Spence MacNamee; a son, Antoine MacNamee, with the Navy in California; a daughter, Mrs. Mable Maple of San Francisco, and a brother.

Funeral services will be held at the Lee Funeral Home, 4th and Massachusetts ave. ne., at 5 p.m. today. Burial will be private.
