Mrs. Annie E. MacNichol died at her home, 208 First street southeast, at 12:40 o'clock Monday morning, aged 87 years. She came to Washington in 1861 and had been a resident ever since. She was the widow of Charles MacNichol. Mrs. MacNichol was prominent in charity and church work, was a life member of the Woman's Home Missionary Society, Home for the Aged, Sibley Hospital, and Trinity Methodist Church. The funeral will take place tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock from her late residence, and the interment will be at Congressional Cemetery.
