Miss Maedel's Funeral

Piano Teacher Had Taught Here For Over Thirty-Five Years

Funeral services for Miss Julia M. Maedel, who died suddenly at her home, No. 609 North Carolina avenue southeast, Saturday, will be held at 3:30 o'clock this afternoon in the lecture room of the Church of the Reformation, where for years she gave an annual recital by her pupils.

Miss Maedel was well known as a piano teacher and had taught in this city for more than thirty-five years. In her classes she frequently had children and even grandchildren of her former pupils. She was preparing to give a recital by her pupils, and it is thought that her efforts overtaxed her strength and caused her death. She was sixty-two years old.
