Boy Drowns in Potomac

Martin Manning Loses Life While Swimming in River

Martin Manning, thirteen years old, 26 2d street northeast, lost his life yesterday afternoon while swimming in the river near Aqueduct bridge. Several other boys were in the water when young Manning, probably seized with cramps, went beneath the surface of the water.

John Ramsey, residing in a houseboat near the scene of the accident, recovered the boy about forty-five minutes later and turned it over to policeman Birkigt.

Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of accidental death.
