

George Washington May

(1789 – 16 Sep 1845)

May. Died, at his residence, in this city, yesterday morning, at six o'clock, after a long and painful illness, which he sustained with exemplary fortitude and pious resignation to the will of his Maker, Dr. George Washington May, in the 56th year of his age. Dr. M. was a native of the city of Boston, and a graduate of Harvard, but the prime and manhood of his life had been spent in this city, where he practiced medicine with high reputation.

His funeral will take place at 4 o'clock this evening, from his late residence, at which the friends of the family are requested to attend without further invitation.
