Funeral of Dr. McBlair

Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock over the remains of Dr. John Hollins McBlair, at the late residence, 2029 I street northwest. The deceased was born in this city 56 years ago. He was appointed a first lieutenant in the 15th Regiment, United States Regulars, in 1861, but sickness compelled his retirement in 1863. He then entered the Georgetown University Medical School, where he was graduated in 1868, and since then has practiced in this city. He was unmarried, but leaves a mother, two sisters and Chas. R. McBlair, a brother.
