Death of Mrs. A.H. McCormick

Annapolis, Md., Jan. 29.

The wife of Rear Admiral A.H. McCormick, U.S.N., retired, died here today of a chronic trouble. She was the daughter of the late William E. Howard, of Washington, and leaves four children, A.H. McCormick, jr., attached to the Navy Department at Washington; Howard McCormick, of the Baltimore bar, and the Misses McCormick, of Annapolis. The two brothers of Mrs. McCormick are C.W. Howard and H.P. Howard, of Washington, and Mrs. Pigman, wife of Capt. Pigman, U.S.N., is her sister. Mrs. McCormick was also a sister of Mrs. Abraham Claude, of Annapolis.
