### **Dead**

Yesterday morning, Mr. John W. McElfresh, a well-known resident of the Seventh Ward, and quartermaster in the Painters' department of the Navy Yard, died after a short illness of typhoid fever, at his residence on south F street, Mr. McElfresh had filled the position of quartermaster of the painters gang for over two years past, and was highly popular among the officers and men of the yard. His funeral will take place tomorrow afternoon.
