Court Asked to Take Action

The National Union, by William Briggs, president, and J.W. Myers, secretary, today asked the Supreme Court of the District of Columbia to require Elizabeth L. McGuirk, widow of the late James McGuirk, and Florie A. McGuirk and John H. McGuirk, children of the deceased and stepchildren of Elizabeth L. McGuirk, to interplead among themselves as to the distribution of \$2,000, a benefit due because of the death of the deceased, payable by the National Union.
