Motor Cycle Auto Crash Victim Dies

Skull Fracture Fatal to John McWilliamson

John E. McWilliamson, forty-nine years old, 634 E street southeast, died at Casualty Hospital early today as a result of a fracture of the skull and cerebral hemorrhage, having been injured in a traffic accident early last evening.

John Birmingham, thirty-five years old, 600 S street southeast, occupant of the sidecar of McWilliamson's motor cycle when the accident happened, received serious injuries to his head and body. He was treated at Casualty Hospital and taken home.

It was shortly after 6 o'clock last night when the motor cycle struck the automobile of Henry Pierson, 604 Alabama avenue southeast, parked near Nichols avenue and Livingston road, Anacostia. McWilliamson is survived by his wife and two children.
