Will of Laura G. Meehan

The will of Laura G. Meehan, dated May 23, 1893, has been filed for probate. The entire estate, including house No. 127 C street southeast is devised to Margaret L. Skerrett, wife of Rear Admiral Skerrett, for the support of Anna Meehan, a sister of the decedent. At the death of Anna Meehan the property is to vest absolutely in Mrs. Skerrett, who is also named as executrix.

Will dated May 23, 1893. She leaves a painting, "Shipwrecked" to her nephew Robert G. Skerrett, \$300 to her friend Laura Campbell premises, 127 C street southeast to niece Margaret L. Skerrett for the benefit and use of Anna Meehan, a sister of the testatrix. Upon the death of the later the property is to revert to her niece.
