Grace Merryman, 90, a retired accounts clerk with the Hecht Co. department store and a member of the Congress Heights United Methodist Church in Washington, died of congestive heart failure April 5 at Southern Maryland Hospital in Clinton.

A resident of Oxon Hill, Mrs. Merryman was born in Washington. She graduated from Eastern High School and attended Strayer College.

In the early 1920s, she was a telephone operator for Western Union. In 1931, she went to work for the Hecht Co. She retired in 1966 and then became a part-time employee of the Naval Research Laboratory and the American Red Cross until about 1970.

Mrs. Merryman was a member of the Julia Hall Chapter No. 107 of the Order of the Eastern Star in Hollywood, Md.

Her husband, Earl Merryman, died in 1951.

Survivors include a daughter, Grace Sheaffer of Tall Timbers, Md., and a brother, Bertrum Glick of Oxon Hill.
