

Jesse Middleton Dies

Was Well Known for Prowress as Fisherman and Nimrod

Jesse Middleton died at the Garfield Hospital yesterday afternoon. He was sixty-five years old and was a son of the late B.F. Middleton of the old firm of Middleton & Bell.

Mr. Middleton is survived by his sister, Mrs. Marion Hyatt of the Maury apartments. He was connected with the firm of Junn & Co., patent attorneys, for years. He was one of the most expert fly fishermen of this city and spent practically his entire time outside of his business hours on or near the water.

For a number of years he resided at Four Mile Run Va., with the family of Thomas Taylor. Mr. Middleton at that time usually arose early in the morning and caught a string of fish before breakfast. In the evening after dinner he was usually to be found on the water until after dark trying his luck. Mr. Middleton also was a crack shot with a rifle. He at one time had a kennel of fine hunting dogs.

Funeral services will be held at Speare's chapel tomorrow morning at 10:30 o'clock.
