

Death Claims R.E. Miles Retired Business Man Long Active in Charity Work

Richard E. Miles, for twenty-four years an active businessman in Southeast Washington, died suddenly Tuesday, November 14, at his home, 18 3d street southeast. Funeral services were held this morning from St. Peter's Catholic Church, and interment was in Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Miles was a native of Charles county, Md., and came to Washington forty years ago, establishing himself in business in Southeast Washington. He retired from active business life sixteen years ago, and since has occupied himself with works of charity, through the St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Peter's parish, of which he had been a communicant for thirty years. He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Barbara Woodward Miles, and a son, Leo Edward Miles of New York city.
