Uses Mirror In Suicide

Patrick Morgan, Retired Navy Yard Employe, Kills Himself

Using a mirror to direct his aim, Patrick Morgan, 66 year old, former sailor and a retired civilian employe of the navy yard, shot and killed himself eary this morning in his room at 425 Seventh street. Dr. J. Ramsay Nevitt, the coroner, issued a certificate of suicide.
