Mr. Morningstar, Engineer 41 Years At Navy Yard

Harry Turner Morningstar, 85, retired Washington Navy Yard engineer, died yesterday at Sibley Hospital.

Mr. Morningstar, who had lived in Takoma Park, Md., for many years was born in Greenville, Ohio. As a young man he moved to Washington and worked for three years at the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Co.

In 1901, he went to work at the Navy Yard as an electrical engineer, holding this position until he retired in 1942. On retirement, he worked for a time at the Cramps Shipbuilding Co. in Philadelphia as an electrical engineer.

He joined Harmony Masonic Lodge shortly after he arrived in Washington and was raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason in 1901. He received the Grand Lodge Fidelity Medal Award in 1956.

Mr. Morningstar leaves his wife, Susan Wood Morningstar; a stepdaughter, Mrs. Mildred T. Hancock, and a grandson, Stephen L. Hancock, all of 11 Cleveland avenue, Takoma Park, and a granddaughter, Carol Ann Gardner of 1318 Saratoga street N.E.
