Robert J. Murray's Funeral

The funeral of Mr. Robert J. Murray, a well-known member of the bar, took place from St. Patrick's Church at 9:30 this morning, the Rev. Joseph F. McGee conducting the service. The interment was at Congressional cemetery. The pallbearers were selected from his associates at the bar, and were as follows: Messrs. Edw. A. Newman, Neal T. Murray, Woodbury Wheeler, John A. Clarke, Waterman Bagaley and Edwin B. Hay. Though for a long time affected with rheumatism the death of Mr. Murray was quite sudden from a different cause, that of Bright's disease. He was the son of the late John Murray, who was one of the wealthy and prominent citizens. He leaves a widow and three children.
