Calvin Neilson Rites Are Set For Tomorrow

Retired Chief Clerk of Pension Office Had Been Ill for Two Months

Calvin Neilson, 78 years old, retired Government employe and former chief clerk of the Pension Office, died yesterday at his residence, 142 Twelfth street northeast, after an illness of two months.

Mr. Neilson came to Washington 45 years ago, following a brief period of law practice in Perry County, Pa., where he was born.

He served nearly 40 years in the Pension Office, his service including besides a chief clerkship, the position of secretary to numerous pension commissioners. His retirement became effective six years ago. He was a member of the LaFayette Masonic Lodge and the Metropolitan Presbyterian Church.

Funeral services conducted by Rev. Freely Roher, pastor of the Metropolitan Presbyterian Church, will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock at the residence. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
