Gertrude Conlon Neumeyer, 84, who worked for Peoples Life Insurance Co. in Washington for 38 years before retiring in 1968 as the company secretary, died of cancer Dec. 18 in Bethesda at the home of a daughter.

Mrs. Neumeyer was a native of Washington and a graduate of the old Business High School. She joined Peoples in 1930 and worked for many years in its mortgage loan department.
