Mrs. Lillian Norris, Mother of Reporter

Mrs. Lillian Craigen Norris, long-time area resident, died yesterday of coronary thrombosis at a local hospital.

Mrs. Norris, who would have been 83 on November 30, lived with her son, John G. Norris, a reporter for the Washington Post and Times Herald, at 4014 North Twenty-fifth street, Arlington.

Mrs. Norris, who was born in Cumberland, Md., came to this area as a young girl and had resided here since. She was the daughter of Dr. John S. Craigen and the former Anna Martha Minke.

Her husband, Charles Alexander Norris, died here in 1935.

Besides her son Mrs. Norris is survived by Mrs. Lawrence Buell O'Connor, a daughter, and by two grandchildren.

Funeral services are scheduled for 11 a.m. tomorrow at the Gunton Temple Memorial Presbyterian Church, Sixteenth and Newton streets N.W. Burial will follow at the Congressional Cemetery. The body is at the S.H. Hines funeral home.
