Robert W.F. Ogilvie Dies Here at Age of 62 Years Bore Title of Lord Banff and Long Was a Resident of Washington

Robert Walter Findlater Ogilvie, sixty-two years old, a long-time resident of Washington, died suddenly Tuesday, Mr. Ogilvie bore the title of Lord Banff.

Shortly after his marriage to Miss Irma Desha Harmon, granddaughter of Gov. Desha of Kentucky, Mr. Ogilvie and his bride went to Scotland, where he established his right to he earldom of Seafield and the barony of Banff.

Mr. Ogilvie was a graduate of Princeton University and the Columbian Law School. At one time he practiced law in Washington and also held a position in the Department of Labor.
