Frank H. Padgett, former secretary of Typographical Union No. 101 and compositor of The Star and Washington Post, died yesterday afternoon at his residence, 1364 Girard street, following an illness of more than four months. He was sixty years old.

Mr. Padgett was born in Philadelphia. He served as first lieutenant in the old Washington Light Infantry. He was actively engaged in the composing room of the Post up to his illness in February.

Surviving him are his wife and a son, E.F. Padgett of this city. Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed.
