A Fatal Fall from a Train

Chas. Palmer, a resident of South Washington, was killed in a railroad accident at North Berwick, Mass., Saturday. Palmer was an employee of the Great Falls Ice Co., and was on his way to this city with two other employees of the company, in charge of twenty-four horses that were being brought here from the company's ice station on the Kennebec. He was missed from the train, and it is supposed that he fell off and was killed. A search was made for him but he could not be found. His body, which, it appears, was found afterward by the railroad people, will be brought to this city. He was a Swede about forty years old and had been in the employ of the company four or five years.
