George Parsons Funeral To Be Held Tomorrow

Funeral services for George W. Parsons, 71, of 1616 G street S.E., who died Tuesday at Sibley Memorial Hospital after a brief illness, will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow at Hysong's funeral home, 1300 N street N.W. Mr. Parsons, for 44 years an employe of the Post Office Department, was senior assistant superintendent at the time of his death. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.

A native of Saline Mich., Mr. Parsons was a graduate of George Washington University Law School and was a member of the District bar. He worked for the Pension Bureau here for a year before transferring to the Post Office Department in July, 1901. Mr. Parsons served most of his 44 years with the Division of Registered Mails.

Survivors are his widow, Mrs. Ruth A. Parsons; a daughter, Mrs. Eldridge D. Kenrick; a son, Seaman L.C. Lane W. Parsons, all of Washington, and a brother, Grosvenor L. Parsons of Saline.
