Miss Patterson's Funeral

Miss Izora Patterson died Saturday afternoon at the residence of her parents, No. 751 10th street southeast. She was the eldest daughter of Mary J. and Robert T. Patterson. Her death was the result of a recent operation. Miss Patterson was at one time a singer in the choir at St. Teresa's Church. Up to the time of her death she was the leading soprano singer at Christ Church, Navy Yard, and was also a member of Electra Chapter, No. 2, Order of the Eastern Star, of Anacostia. A special meeting of Electra Chapter was held last evening in Masonic Hall, when arrangements were made for the funeral of the deceased member, it being decided that representatives of the chapter should attend in a body, and that the usual ritual be performed. Funeral services over the remains were held this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from Christ Church. The interment was made in Congressional cemetery.
