Miss Peabody died yesterday of a heart ailment at the home of her brother, William F. Peabody, 1503 Delafield place N.W. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Miss Peabody was born and educated in Washington. She taught music for many years in the District, retiring about eight years ago.

In addition to her brother, Miss Peabody is survived by a sister, Miss Irene Peabody, also of the L street address. Miss Peabody lived at 918 L street for more than 73 years.
