Mrs. Pedlow, 88, Active in Church

Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Pedlow, 88, a Washington resident for 50 years, died Saturday at White Plains, N.Y.

Mrs. Pedlow was born in Ashland, Pa., and attended schools there. She was the widow of William Pedlow an employe of the old Navy Yard, who died in 1920.

Mrs. Pedlow, who moved to White Plains about five years ago to live with her daughter, Mrs. George H. Schmidt, had been a member of Epiworth Methodist Church here and was at one time superintendent of the church's Sunday school junior department and home department.

She was also a member of the Women's Society of Christian Service, the Women's Christian Temperance Union, a member of the Sibley Hospital Guild and a charter member of the No. 1 Chapter of American War Mothers here.

In addition to her daughter, Mrs. Pedlow leaves a granddaughter and four great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow at the Lee Funeral Home, Fourth street and Massachusetts avenue N.E., with burial in Congressional Cemetery.
