### **Funeral of Edward K. Plan**

Funeral services over the remains of Edward Knight Plant, who died Christmas day after a short illness at the Casualty Hospital, were held at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the residence of his aunt, Mrs. Mary Brecht, 718 3d street northeast. Interment was made in Congressional cemetery.
