## **Burial of Mouina G. Porter**

## **Ceremony Takes Place To-day in Congressional Cemetery.**

Mouina G. Porter, who died May 24, on the transport Sherman, homeward-bound from the Philippines, will be buried this morning at 10 o'clock in the Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Porter had been connected for twenty-seven years with the War Department. For the past three years he had been in the Quarter Master General's Office, at Manila.

He was a member of a prominent Washington family, a son of Commander [Commodore] William D. Porter, and the nephew of Admiral David D. Porter.

Mr. Porter is survived by his wife. Mrs. Mary S. Porter, who makes her home in New York; a son, Bennet L. Porter, of New York, and a daughter. Mrs. Edna Porter Stiles, of Providence, R.I.
