On Tuesday the 23d instant, at 5 o'clock, p.m. Mrs. Sarah Porter, daughter of the deceased Col. Wm. Ramsay, of the Revolutionary army, and relict of Thomas Porter, Esq. formerly merchant in Alexandria. Mrs. Porter was well known in this District, and highly estimated by all who had the pleasure of her acquaintance. During her long illness, she manifested that resignation to the Divine will which can be felt only by those who, in the exercise of a living faith on the Redeemer, look towards that world where "there is no earth" as their home, and who can say with her, they are "not afraid to die."

The friends of the family are requested to attend her funeral, this afternoon at 3 o'clock, from her late residence, nearly opposite to the Six Buildings.
