Native of Anne Arundel County, Md., Was Retired Commerce Department Official

Walter T. Pumphrey, 62, of 1353 Kennedy street, retired section chief of the Department of Commerce, died yesterday in Emergency Hospital after being stricken on the sidewalk at Fourteenth and L streets.
