John R. Pusey Dies

Had Been Prominent Resident of City Half Century

John R. Pusey, a prominent resident of this city for more than half a century, died yesterday afternoon at his residence, 1211 E street northeast following a short illness. He was eighty-three years old.

Mr. Pusey was born in Pennsylvania in 1837 and came to this city about fifty-five years ago, where he established himself in the retail paper business. He retired from business about six years ago. He has been a member of the Waugh M.E. Church for the past fifty years.

He is survived by two sons, Fred E. Pusey and Howard O. Pusey, and two daughters, Mrs. Fred B. Miller and Mrs. Sylvia Kline, all of this city.

Funeral services will be held from his old residence tomorrow afternoon at 4 o'clock. Interment will be at Congressional cemetery.
