John Pyles Found Dead

Had Applied Few Hours Before for Treatment at Hospital

John Pyles, 47 years old died suddenly in his apartment at 509 E street early this morning from the effects of what doctors at Emergency Hospital said was acute alcoholism. Coroner J. Ramsay Nevitt was notified.

According to police, Pyles had been living at the E street address for nearly three months, following estrangement from his wife. Doctors at the hospital said Pyles had applied there for treatment earlier in the evening, and, after being given attention, was advised to return home and remain in bed. A few hours later the ambulance was called to the E street apartment and Pyles was pronounced dead.
