**Queen.** Yesterday morning in this city, Mrs. Elizabeth Queen in the 79th year of her age. Her funeral will take place from her late residence on Pennsylvania Avenue this morning at 11 o'clock to which her friends are invited.

To Rev. William Matthews, \$25.

Real estate to be sold by Exrs. and proceeds to be equally divided between all children and the heirs of deceased children.

To daughter Eliza, servant William; to daughter Charlotte Henrietta, servant woman Caroline and her child; to daughters Eliza and Charlotte Henrietta, all household and kitchen furniture.

Servant man Charles to be liberated when he arrives at age 27 years, proceeds of his hire until that time to son John Queen for education of two grandsons Walter and William Queen.
