### **Conway B. Ratcliffe Dies**

#### **Funeral Services for Pioneer Printer Tomorrow Afternoon**

Conway B. Ratcliffe, connected with the printing trade for nearly half a century, died yesterday in his sixty-fourth year, at the Casualty Hospital. Funeral services are to be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock at Lee's undertaking parlors, on Pennsylvania avenue. Interment is to be in Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Ratcliffe had been connected during his life here with the government printing office and all of the Washington newspapers. He had not been engaged in his trade for the past several years, being a pensioner. In 192 he was at the Union Printers' Home, at Colorado Springs. He is survived by a brother, Frank Ratcliffe of this city.
