John H. Schwarzmamm

Funeral services were held yesterday at Congressional Cemetery for John H. Schwarzmamm, a District businessman who once tended cattle and later operated a garage and service station on the same Southeast Washington corner.

Mr. Schwarzmamm died Friday at his home, 517 13th st. se., after a short illness. He was 89.

Before retiring in 1947, he owned and operated a gas station at 13th st. and Pennsylvania ave. se., where he had tended cattle as a boy, shortly after coming here from his native Bavaria, Germany.

He succeeded his father in operating a blacksmith shop and building wagons on the same corner. But with the advent of the horseless carriage, he converted the shop to auto repair work and in 1931 to a garage and service station.

Mr. Schwarzmamm was a member of the Masons, Reformation Lutheran Church and the Southeast Businessmen's Association.

He is survived by three sons, Albert, of the home address, Henry, of 1524 28th st. se., and Louis, of 3386 Highview terrace se., and four daughters, Mrs. Lewis W. Adkins, of 713 13th st. se.; Mrs. Andrew S. Wright, of 112 Jefferson st. nw.; Mrs. Charles R. Brown, of 4709 Edmonson ave., Hyattsville; and Mrs. Ralph C. Boyd of 1526 28th st. se.
