Hattie Smith, Roads Agency Aide

Hattie May Smith, 74, a native Washingtonian who worked for the Bureau of Public Roads for nearly 50 years died Saturday at her home in Washington after a long illness.

She was the widow of Frederick W. Smith, a Justice Department lawyer, who died in 1972.
