Funeral of Mrs. W.C. Sowder

The funeral services over the remains of the late Mrs. William C. Sowder will take place tomorrow evening at the family residence, 95th street southeast, at 6:30 o'clock. Rev. Charles M. Butler, pastor of the Kellar Memorial Lutheran Church, will preach the sermon. The interment, which will be private, will take place Friday morning at 10 o'clock and will be in Congressional cemetery. The pallbearers will be Mr. R.H. Payne, Mr. E.G. Farrell, Mr. Elmer Edmonston, Mr. George F. Stack, Mr. Thomas Carroll and Mr. William H. Allen. Mrs. Sowder, who was a sister of Mr. P.V. DeGraw, fourth assistant postmaster general, was recently operated upon for appendicitis and until Monday evening seemed to have withstood the operation well. Unfavorable symptoms, which could not be controlled by the physicians, developed and the end came peacefully at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon.
