Mrs. Stewart Dies When Badly Burned

Woman of Seventy Years Is Found in Faint on the Floor by a Neighbor

Mrs. Odelia Stewart, seventy, of 1211 F street, died at the Emergency Hospital late yesterday afternoon as the result of burns received Wednesday morning when a gas stove flares, at which she was preparing dinner, ignited her clothing.

She was seriously burned about the head and body, and fainted after beating the flames out of her clothing.

Mrs. C.H. Werne of Wardman Park Hotel, who went to the home to visit the victim, found her on the floor. She was immediately sent to Emergency Hospital, where efforts to save her life were fruitless.
