P.A. Taltavull, 70, Undertaker, Dies

Funeral Services Will Be Held Tomorrow Morning at St. Dominic's

Peter A. Taltavull, lifetime resident of this city and an undertaker for more than 25 years, died at his home, 423 Buchanan street, Wednesday, after an illness of several months.

Mr. Taltavull, who was 70, was educated in the public schools here, entering business for himself after serving with other local undertaking establishments. His son, W. Warren Taltavull, who was also an undertaker, died about three weeks ago.
