Dr. E.C. Varela Dies

For Twenty-Seven Years An Employe of the General Land Office

Dr. Ernest C. Varela, for twenty-seven years an employe of the general land office Department of the Interior, died at the Emergency Hospital yesterday morning at 7:20 o'clock from internal congestion and shock resulting from injuries received July 10 in a fall of approximately twenty-five feet in the new building of the Department of the Interior, due to an attack of vertigo.
