Yesterday, the funeral of Capt. Wm. M. Walker took place from his residence by I street and was attended by a number of officers of the navy. A company of the U.S. marines, commanded by Capt. Hayward, accompanied by the band, acted as an escort to the Congressional Cemetery.

### **Orphans' Court**

Today, the will of the late Capt. William M. Walker, U.S.N., bequeathing his property to his mother, Mrs. Caroline H. Walker, was filed and fully proved, as also a renunciation of Mrs. Walker of her right to administer, in favor of A. Thomas Bradley, and letters of administration with the will annexed were issued to him; bond \$50,000.
