Dose Of Lye Is Fatal

Child Dies After Swallowing Small Quantity of Liquid

Austin Weaver, two and one-half years old, playing about the bathroom at his home, 462 H street southwest, last night about 8 o'clock, got hold of a can of concentrated lye. He put a small quantity of the lye, in his mouth and was severely burned.

The sufferer was taken to Casualty Hospital, where he died at 5:50 o'clock this morning. Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of accidental death.
