Burton Webster, 76, Native of City, Dies Bruise on Head Causes Coroner to Order Autopsy --Friends Say He Suffered Accident

Burton Webster, 76, a lifelong resident of Washington, died yesterday shortly after he was found unconscious in the third-floor room which he occupied at 1314 Belmont street.

Coroner A. Magruder MacDonald examined the body and found a bruise on the back of the head, which might have contributed to the death. Friends said Webster had suffered an accidental fall while downtown about a week ago.

Coroner MacDonald ordered an autopsy to determine the cause of death.

Webster left no immediate survivors. Funeral arrangements have not been completed.
