3 Montgomery County Youths Killed in Head-On Collision in New Mexico

Three Montgomery County youths, returning from a trip to the West Coast, were killed at 2 a.m.

yesterday in a head-on collision with another car north of Socorro, N. Mex.

They were Philip Toby Allen, 20, of 12804 Bluehill Road, Wheaton; Patrick Hall, 19, of 3607 Astoria Road, Kensington, and Charles Alton White Jr., 19, of 1806 August Drive, Bethesda.

They had driven to Los Angeles, their parents said, to see the country and have some fun, and were returning home. The parents were informed by police that the boys' car crashed head-on with a car carrying a family from Salem, Ore.

Five in the other car were injured and an infant, 5 months old, was killed. The crash occurred on a section of Interstate 25 where it narrowed because of construction work.

Allen Was Wheaton Graduate

Philip Allen, a voracious reader of science fiction who hoped to work in psychology or sociology and a graduate of Wheaton High School was the son of Mr. and Mrs. George I. Allen and the brother of Woodley, 18, and Richard, 12, all of the home address. Mr. Allen is a statistician in the office of the Army Surgeon General.

Young Allen was a reservist with an Army medical unit here and spent six months on active duty last year.

Patrick Hall, who was born in Arras, France, and lived in the Washington area eight years, was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert B. Hall. The Halls' other children are Joelle, 18; Frankie, 15; Terry, 5, and Michael, 22, who is with the Air Force in Thailand. Mr. Hall is assistant director of the General Accounting Office.

Patrick had graduated from Einstein High School and attended Bellarmine College in Louisville, Ky., and Maryland University.

His mother said, "He wanted to have some fun and see the country before he got drafted. He was going to stay in L.A. until Christmas."

Called Home Monday

Monday night, however, he called home and said he and his friends were returning right away. He said he would explain when he got home.

Charles Alton White was the son of Mrs. Jean White of the home address. He leaves his wife, Wanda; a brother, Stephen, 14, and a sister, Deborah, 12.

Born in Washington, he attended Our Lady of Good Counsel High School and was graduated from Northwood High School in Silver Spring.
