Williams. On Wednesday, the 3d inst., after a brief illness, Samuel S. Williams, in the 42d year of his age. The funeral will take place on Saturday, the 6th inst., at 3 p.m. from his late residence, No. 271 8th street, between M and N.

Dead –

S.S. Williams, Esq., a well known lawyer of this city, died yesterday of typhoid fever. His death was unexpected although he has been ill for some days. Attending Mr. Williams death is a circumstance which well illustrates the really beneficial effect of Life Insurance Companies.
