Julian G. Zier, 58, a retired employe of the Pan American Union, died at the home of a brother-in-law, Roy C. Hoover, in Atlantic City, N.J., yesterday after a long illness.

Mr. Zier has been a resident of Atlantic City since he retired in 1947 as chief of the statistical division of the Pan American Union.

Mr. Zier was a graduate of Georgetown University. After his retirement from the Pan American Union, he worked for the International Telecommunications Commission at Atlantic City.

He is survived by two brothers, Jerry F. of Philadelphia, and L. Clifton of Arlington, and by a niece, Mildred Carroll, also of Arlington.

A requiem mass will be said at 9 a.m. Monday at the Holy Spirit Church in Atlantic City. Graveside services and burial will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday at Congressional Cemetery in Washington.
